after which time no entries may be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted, corrected, completed or signed and no entry fees refunded. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows published by the American Kennel Club.

To pay for an entry scanned and attached to email to PARRKEES@mac.com use PayPal services, payable to account for PARRKEES@mac.com. Add \$4.00 for each entry form to the correct entry fee amount. You must email the front and back of entry form for it to be accepted, completely filled out and signed. Notification must be received by the show secretary from PayPal that the funds have been deposited before the entry will be accepted.

Entries not on an official AKC entry form are not acceptable and photocopies of the entry form must have the Agreement and Instructions on the back included.

The Basset Hound Club of Southern California, Inc. may deny entries to these shows due to outstanding monetary obligations to the club.

Effective for all events held after January 1, 2024, the AKC will collect a \$3.00 Event Service Fee for the first entry of a dog and a \$3.50 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes, in all AKC licensed and member club events. (There is no recording fee or event service fee for sweepstakes, futurities, brace/team, multi-dog classes, or special attractions.) The current \$.50 recording fee will continue to be collected. The event-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Event Service Fees for the American Kennel Club. That fact shall be stated in the premium list. These event service and recording fees shall be forwarded to the American Kennel Club along with all other required event results within seven (7) days of the close of the event.

Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks, whoever may make such errors. Entry fees will not be refunded in event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, bitch in season, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. If, because of extreme weather, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund or entry fee(s) will be made.

Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose championship is unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Best of Breed competition, provided the transfer is made with the show secretary at least one-half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

Acknowledgment of entry will be made with an exhibitor's ticket and judging program. If not received within a reasonable time prior to the show, notify the show secretary at (760) 946-9048. Consult Judging Program for time of judging.

Exhibitors and handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their area.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure that their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Best of Breed The Basset Hound Club of Southern California offers a Waterford Bowl on a walnut base.

Best of Opp. Sex to Best of Breed Woebgon Bassets, Don and Pam Bullock present a large Dannyquest cold-cast bronze Basset Hound bitch on a hand-crafted curly maple base with plaques. The trophy is presented in honor of their three bitches who previously won this award: GCH. Woebgon's Kickapoo Joy Juice, ROM in 2005, CH. Woebgon's Snow White from the BBEX Class in 2007 and GCH. Woebgon's Dodge City Sarsaparilla in 2013.

Field Trial Dogs

Field Trial Bitches

NR1.08500. The Field Trial Dog and Bitch Classes are open to any Basset Hound which has placed in an AKC member or licensed Field Trial. Judging will be on conformation only and the winners of the Field Trial Dog and Field Trial Bitch classes may compete for Best of Breed if otherwise undefeated on the day of the show. A photocopy of the ribbon earned must accompany entry in the Field Trial classes. Entrants in the Field Trial Classes must be intact.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

JUDGE'S AWARDS OF MERIT

At the judge's discretion, an award of merit may be given after awarding BOB, BOS, BOW, Select Dog and Select Bitch to any other basset remaining in the ring. The formula for determining how many Awards of Merit can be given will be: one (1) Award of Merit for every seven (7) entries with five (5) being the maximum.

Awarded after Best of Breed Competition:

SATURDAY: BEST PUPPY

(6-9 mos. class winners & 9-12 mos. class winners)

SUNDAY: BEST BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR

(BBX class winners)

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

Stud Dog Class – For dogs that have sired two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award will be based on the merits of the two get, get only to be judged. The owner of the Stud Dog need not be the owner of the get. As the judge's decision in this class will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. The Stud Dog must appear in the ring with his two get (not more than 6) and be entered in the Stud Dog Class.

Brood Bitch Class – For bitches that have whelped two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award will be based on the merits of the produce. The owner of the Brood Bitch need not be the owner of the produce. As the judge's decision in this class will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. The Brood Bitch must appear in the ring with her produce (not more than 6) and must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class.

Brace Class – For two (2) dogs or bitches of the same breed with at least one common owner. Both entrants must be intact.

PARADE OF TITLE HOLDERS

Dogs that are AKC Champions of Record and dogs that have an AKC Obedience, Rally, Agility, or Tracking degree may be entered for the Parade of Titleholders only. Each dog so entered will be presented with a Rosette with the dog's name printed on it in goldleaf. Each dog's name and the owners' names will be announced at the time of presentation of the Rosette. \$18.00.

Two Puppy Sweepstakes

1. A dog shown in the Sweepstakes MUST ALSO be entered in a conformation class at the regular fee. No champions may be shown in the Sweepstakes
2. Entry fee in the Sweepstakes is \$18.00 per dog or bitch.
There will be six class divisions:

Puppy Dogs, 6 mos. & under 9 mos.	Puppy Bitches, 6 mos. & under 9 mos.
Puppy Dogs, 9 mos. & under 12 mos.	Puppy Bitches, 9 mos. & under 12 mos.
Dogs, 12 mos. & under 18 mos.	Bitches, 12 mos. & under 18 mos.
3. The six classes will be judged separately and the winner of each class will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Sweepstakes.
4. All Sweepstakes entry fees in each class division will be divided as follows:
First Prize – 40% Second Prize – 30% Third Prize – 20% Fourth Prize – 10%
5. In the event of less than four(4) dogs, the balance of the percentage will be divided among those entered. Said percentage will be calculated on the total moneys received from all entry fees for the Sweepstakes, after deducting 30% for expenses.

1. A dog shown in Veteran Sweepstakes NEED NOT be entered in a conformation class at this show.
2. Entry fee in the Sweepstakes is \$18.00 per dog or bitch.
There will be six class divisions:

Dogs, 6 years and under 9 years	Bitches, 6 years and under 9 years
Dogs, 9 years and under 11 years	Bitches, 9 years and under 11 years
Dogs, 11 years and older	Bitches, 11 years and older
3. The six classes will be judged separately and the winner of each class will compete for Best in Veteran Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Veteran Sweepstakes.
4. All Veteran Sweepstakes entry fees in each class division will be divided as follows:
First Prize – 40% Second Prize – 30% Third Prize – 20% Fourth Prize – 10%
5. In the event of less than four(4) dogs, the balance of the percentage will be divided among those entered. Said percentage will be calculated on the total monies received from all entry fees for the Sweepstakes, after deducting 30% for expenses.
6. PROFESSIONAL AND/OR PAID HANDLERS MAY ONLY SHOW DOGS THEY OWN IN SWEEPSTAKES.

Directions to Show

Featherly Regional Park • Canyon RV Park is conveniently situated on the Northwest corner of the 91 Freeway and Gypsum Canyon Road in Anaheim, California.

From the west: Traveling eastbound on the CA-91 Fwy, pass Weir Canyon Road. Take Exit 41 for Gypsum Canyon Road. Turn left at the bottom of the off-ramp. Pass under freeway and turn left at the signal. This will lead you right into the entrance. Follow directional signs to show site parking lot.

From the east: Traveling westbound on the CA-91 Fwy toward Beach Cities, pass Green River Road. Take Exit 41A for Gypsum Canyon Road. At the bottom of the off-ramp continue straight through the signal into the park entrance. Follow directional signs to show site parking lot..

ALL CHALLENGE TROPHIES — Trophy must be returned to the trophy chairman in satisfactory condition and properly engraved prior to the official start of the next specialty show. Excessive damage (damage beyond normal wear and tear) should be repaired prior to the return of the trophy. Engraving charges will be reimbursed upon presentation of bill to club treasurer. No trophies will be mailed.

The challenge trophies are offered by various donors through the Basset Hound Club of Southern California for competition at its specialty shows only. For permanent possession, these trophies must be won three times by the same owner(s) not necessarily with the same dog or bitch.

AGREEMENT

I/we agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I/we agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND/OR THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
